


HERTBEATS 2019 OUTINGS PROGRAMME

“The Mousetrap” at the St.Martins Theatre, London - Thursday,14th March 2019



An opportunity to see Agatha Christie's greatest creation in the West where it has set the world record of a 66 years run.

We have Stall seats for the Matinee performance and the cost of the Outing, including the Coach and Theatre Ticket, is £32 per person.

The Imperial War Museum at Duxford - Wednesday, 24th April 2019

Duxford is Britain's largest aviation museum housing nearly 200 aircraft plus military vehicles, artillery and minor naval vessels in seven main exhibition buildings. The site accommodates the American Museum containing US aircraft and militaria and two regimental museums.



The cost of the Outing is £26 per person.

The Bombay Sapphire Distillery and The Vyne NT property - Thursday, 23rd May 2019



The Bombay Sapphire Distillery is located at Laverstoke Mill near Basingstoke and dates back to the 11th Century predating the the birth of Bombay Sapphire Gin in 1761. It is now used to separate the botanicals from the grain spirit and capture the botanicals in the vapour in a process dating back to 1831.

The Vyne was built for Lord Sandys, Henry VIII's Lord Chamberlain before passing to the Chute family. The estate underwent considerable renovation in the 19th century and has recently reopened after a £2.5m roof refurbishment.



The cost of the Outing is £27 for Members of the National Trust and £37 for non-members. The cost of the Outing includes admission to Laverstoke Mill and and audio guided tour of the Distillery and tasting.

The Bluebell Railway and Borde Hill Gardens - Wednesday, 26th June 2019



We take a ride on the the Bluebell Railway from East Grinstead along the full length of the railway to Sheffield Park on the first preserved steam passenger railway in the world.

A short coach journey takes us to Borde Hill Gardens for Lunch and the rest of the day. The Gardens are set in 200 acres of garden, park and woodlands overlooking the Sussex High Weald. The garden is planted in "rooms" each offering different character and styles.



The cost of the Outing, including the Coach, train Ticket and Admission to the Gardens is £xx.

Hever Castle - Wednesday, 24th July 2019



Originally built as a country house in the 13th Century it became the seat of the Boleyn family from 1462 to 1539. Anne Boleyn spent part of her youth at Hever after her father inherited it in 1505.

The cost of the Outing is £26 per person.


Polesden Lacey - Wednesday, 11th September 2019

Polesden Lacey is an Edwardian National Trust property that was expanded from a Regency house and extensively remodelled in 1906 by Margaret Granville. Her collection of fine paintings, furniture, porcelain and silver is on display in the reception rooms and galleries. The house includes grounds of 1,400 acres with a walled rose garden, lawns and ancient woodland walks.



The cost of the Outing is £13 for National Trust members and £25 for non-members.

"Kinky Boots" at Milton Keynes Theatre - Wednesday, 30th October 2019



Charlie Price is struggling to keep his father's shoe factory in business until help arrives in the form of Toal a fabulous performer in need of some sturdy stilettos. With songs by Cindi Lauper this musical is about the friendships we discover and the belief that you can change the world. Winner of the 2016 Olivier Award for Best new Musical.

The cost of the Outing is £40 per person including Stall Seats and the Coach.
